How To Stop Rattling Doors Using Rubber Tacks

Now we hate to sound like a broken record, but if the door is still rattling, this is absolutely guaranteed to do the trick.

Utensils

Hammer

Ingredients

Rubber tack button (available at hardware store)

Approximate Time: 5 Minutes




Figure 29. Rubber Tack Procedure

- 1. With hammer, nail rubber tack into the very highest corner at the top of the latch side of the door facing stop. See Figure 29A.
- 2. Once nailed into place, the rubber tack button creates a springlike action as it comes in contact with the door, thus eliminating the rattling (Fig. 29B).

Note: We have no further advice if your door continues to rattle. Maybe you should move.
