## **How To Adjust Timing of Flush Valve Water Flow**

There is nothing worse than half a flush when a full flush is what you need. Like the poker four-flush, it doesn't quite make for a winner.

## **Utensils**

Smooth or flat-jaw adjustable wrench Medium flat blade screwdriver

## **Approximate Time: 5 To 10 Minutes**

- 1. Do not cut off water supply.




Figure 84. Adjusting the Water Supply

- 2. Remove nut on top of valve assembly (Fig. 84A).
- 3. Turn screw that is beneath nut in counterclockwise direction, one-fourth turn at a time (Fig. 84B).
- 4. Flush intermittently until proper amount of water is passed through.
- 5. If this doesn't do the trick, go on to the next recipe.
